As an employee, you have rights that protect you against health and safety hazards on the job. You have the right to participate in workplace health and safety issues and to know about any potential hazards.

Workplace hazards can be physical (i.e. constant loud noise), biological (i.e. bacteria and viruses), ergonomic (i.e. improperly adjusted workstations and chairs) or chemical (i.e. exposure to fumes).
